

District 197 Grade Acceleration Request Form

Prior to requesting Grade Level Acceleration, District 197 has **established minimum criteria** for consideration. The criteria consist of:

Being identified as a Tier 3 student by the current district Gifted Identification Process,

OR

Academic Achievement results in math AND reading as measured by MAP 2-5 (for students in grades 1 - 4) or MAP 6+ (for students in grades 5 and up) at the 98% or higher and two years ahead of their current placement

AND

Cognitive Ability Test (CogAt) - Composite Score of 130+

If a student has not taken the Cognitive Ability Test or the MAP Math or Reading test, the district will arrange for the test to be taken but the student must have been enrolled in the district for at least 6 months.

Requests must be completed by May 15 for consideration for the following school year.
